Trash Dumpsters

The dumpsters are for ordinary household garbage only. Appliances, construction debris, furniture and other unusual items should not be placed in the dumpsters or enclosure area. Bulk trash can be picked up by one of the several private collection services in the area.

Several occurrences have been reported of trash strewn around the dumpster area. If this is your trash please gather it and place it in the dumpster. A shovel and broom are available on the back wall of the dumpster area for your use. Please also close the dumpster doors after making any deposits as wildlife (racoons, squirrels, possums, etc) have been reported in the dumpster area.

In case of Emergency

Please report any water leaks, exterior damage or repairs to Cedar Management. Cedar accepts calls 24 hours per day.

If you have a medical emergency, fire or safety concern, please first call 911.

Several residents have reported suspicious and unknown persons and cars in the community. If you observe these and are unsure if they belong here, call 911. DO NOT APPROACH any suspicious persons yourself.

Pet Leashes and Etiquette

All pets must be on leashes or other *physical restraint* when outside. There are no exceptions. This is Mecklenburg County law and Yachtsman rule and applies to all pets when outdoors. Electric leashes that are not physically connected between the pet and its handler are not adequate according to the County. Residents have reported being "charged" by otherwise friendly pets that were not adequately restrained. Documented service animals must also be restrained.

We continue to get complaints about pet waste not being picked up. This is not only inconsiderate to your neighbors, unhealthy to the environment and unsightly, it is required by Mecklenburg County and our rules.

Those that observe pets whose waste is not picked up may report the violation to violations@mycmg.com. Please include the community (Yachtsman), name/address of the violator, date/time of violation and description of the pet (breed, color). A picture would be helpful if you can get one.
